

Emergency Correctionville City Council Meeting – June 25, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: The Correctionville City Council met in Emergency session on June 25, 2024, at the Correctionville City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 AM by Mayor Ken Bauer.

ROLL CALL: Council members answering roll: Adam Petty, Kourtnee Mammen, Bob Beazley, Nathan Heilman and Ciara Alioth. Absent: None.

EMERGENCY ISSUE NEW BUSINESS:

Per Code of Iowa 21.4, If an emergency situation requires a meeting with less than 24 hours’ notice, give as much notice as can be given, but in any event, give at least some notice. The city must justify its reason for not giving 24 hours’ notice in the minutes of the meeting. The city must also justify its action if it holds a meeting at a place not reasonably accessible or at a time not reasonably convenient to the public.

Mayor Ken Bauer called an emergency meeting of the Correctionville City Council to discuss the emergent situation with the flooding occurring in the city. This meeting was held in the Council Chambers with several responding emergency agencies also attending. The life and safety of our citizens and structures and homes were discussed. No action was taken.
