SITE PLAN

1. Indicate North point and abutting roads.
2. Show locations of all structures and driveways; indicate if new or existing.
3. Show dimensions of proposed structures and other development, expressed in feet.
4. Show off street parking and loading areas with dimensions. Contact the city clerk for specific rules.
5. There may be designated setbacks that vary from one zoning district to another. The property owner is responsible and liable for exact measurements from all lot lines and road right of way lines. Check with the city clerk for zoning setbacks in the district that you are improving.
6. Designated flood areas require a flood plain development permit which includes additional restrictions.
7. Application and drawings must be completed in its entirety and returned with the filing fee before it will be processed and approved.
